

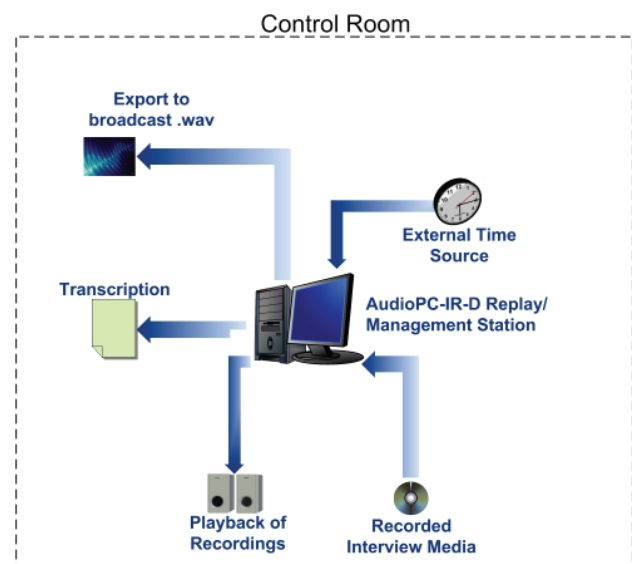
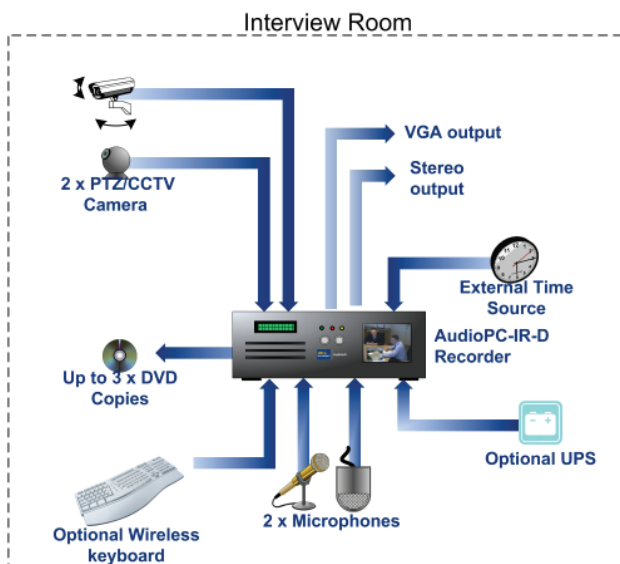
PACE Interview Recorder - Transcription Friendly

Legally Admissible Recording

Fully compliant with PACE Codes of Practice, recordings are legally admissible and are produced using high quality audiovisual hardware combined with proven AudioSoft software. A robust and fault tolerant solution, recordings are simultaneously written to both DVD and integral Hard Disc, with the added option of a network connection, recording directly to a centralised data hub. With just a start and stop button on the front panel, the production of high quality interview recordings could not be easier and the completed DVD-R discs can be replayed in standard DVD players.

Benefits of Networking Recorders

The connection of digital recorders across a secure digital network (SDN) offer many advantages. For example, individual recorders may be configured, controlled and monitored from a secure web browser interface. In practice, this means recorders can be easily installed and ongoing support and health monitoring may be provided over a network from a remote location. Seamless network integration supports many other beneficial features such as centralised data storage, and with a few clicks of a mouse, interviews may be streamed live to team members not present at the actual interview. Alternatively, sections of previously stored interviews can be watched or transferred for transcription or courtroom purposes.



Start Recording - The DVD disks integrity is automatically checked prior to recording and the recorder can be configured at installation to require, either one, two or three DVD's, producing tamperproof "write-once" master and working copies of the interview. DVD-R Media is optionally available in branded jewelled and sealed cases which can be opened and annotated in front of the interviewee.



Finalise Recording - Recordings are finalised and a ten second summary of each disc is played on the LCD monitor before media is ejected. Additional security is provided should power fail at any point during the interview session, recordings will be undamaged and will be automatically finalised to DVD via the internal battery back-up.

Video Standard - TV quality frame rate at 25 fps with a resolution of 720 x 540 pixels is recorded via two video cameras. The images are simultaneously recorded to disc and displayed as Picture-in-Picture (PiP) on the front panel-mounted LCD screen.

Audio Standard - Recorded and replayed as left and right stereo channels via two microphones carefully positioned within the room to avoid any unnecessary background noise. Good quality microphones are strongly recommended for the supported CD quality sample rate of 48KHz and 16 bit sample size.

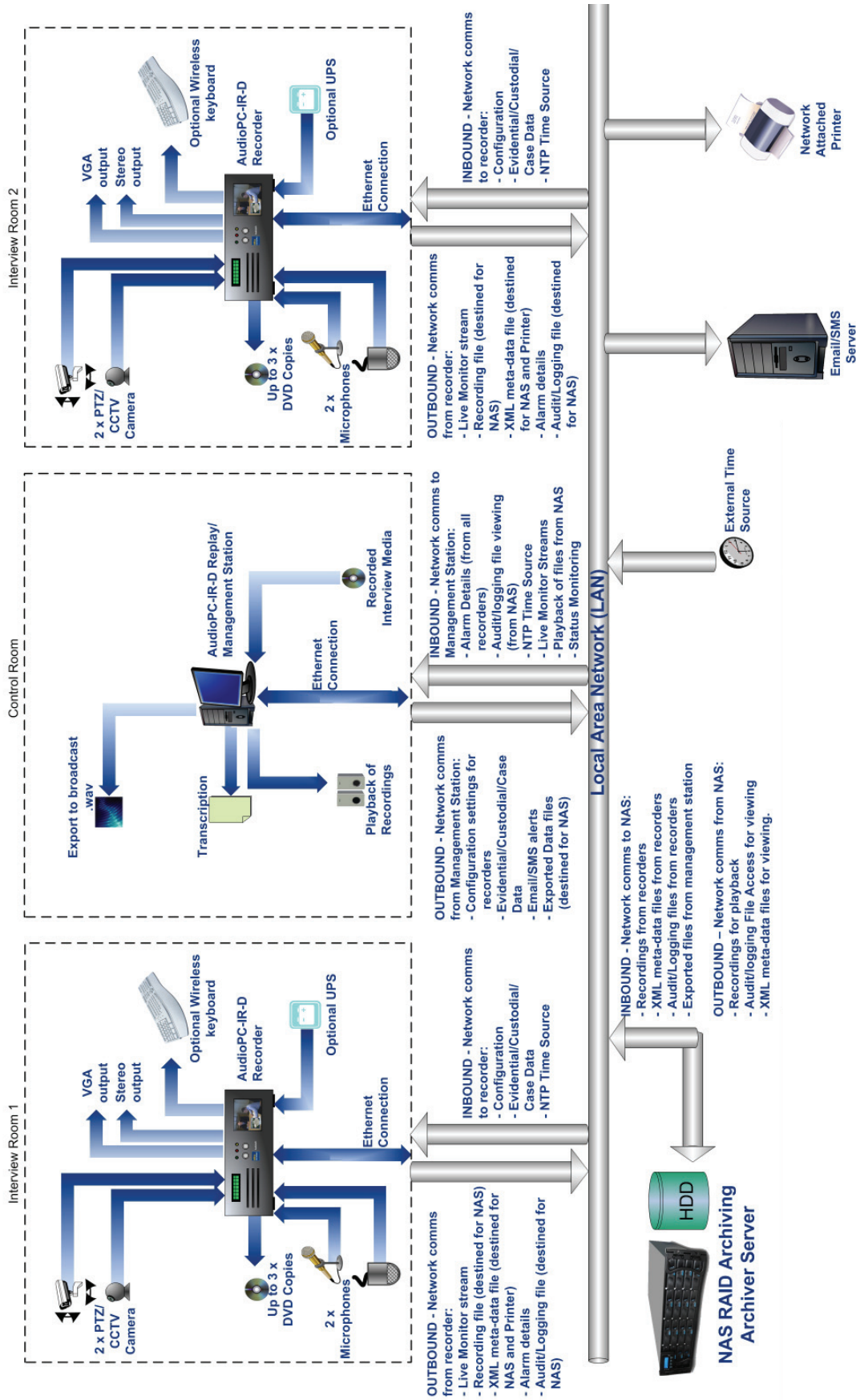
